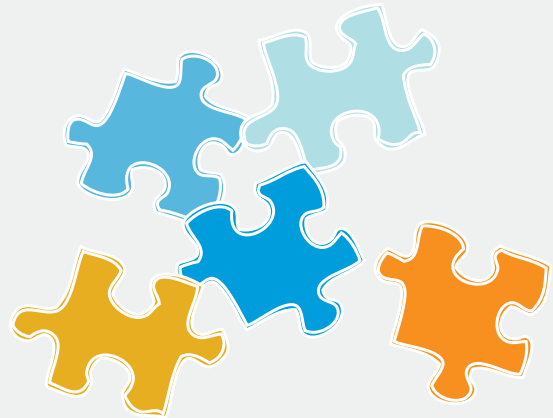


Some seniors recover faster than others after hip fracture and no one knows why...
