MOVING TOWARDS THE LEARNING HEALTH CARE SYSTEM

Integrating Research into Practice and Policy

The “Learning Healthcare System” (LHCS) is posited as a strategy to rapidly improve quality of care, health outcomes, and reduce costs.

The LHCS leverages advanced information technology to continuously collect data, apply evidence in real time, and perform rapid-cycle evaluation and improvement cycles. Dr. Robert Reid will discuss the role of research in the LHCS and ways to embed research in healthcare operations.



Dr. Robert Reid, MD, PhD

Dr. Robert Reid is Medical Director for Research Translation at Group Health Cooperative and Senior Investigator at the Group Health Research Institute. His research and leadership roles in health system learning revolve around developing and testing innovations in primary care, preventive services, and chronic care delivery. Dr. Reid is also Affiliate Associate Professor of Health Services at the University of Washington and Adjunct Professor of Population and Public Health at the University of British Columbia.

Dr. Reid obtained his medical degree at the University of Alberta. He completed an MPH in epidemiology, a medical residency in public health, and a PhD in health policy and management at the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health. Dr. Reid is a Fellow of the American College of Preventive Medicine.
