

Healthy male volunteers in their 50's needed for research study on depression

PURPOSE OF THIS STUDY:

We are recruiting healthy male volunteers for a comparison group to learn about brain function differences associated with Major Depression and to characterize changes that occur with its treatment and recovery.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Do not have a history of psychiatric illnesses
- In good health
- Male, between 51-60 years of age
- Willing to undergo brain scans and psychological tests

Please note that you must not currently be using any recreational and/or non-prescription drugs or have a drinking problem. Participants will be matched to our patient group by demographics.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

In this study, we will be collecting information from psychological questionnaires, cognitive testing, and brain scans. You will not receive treatment of any kind as part of this healthy comparison group.
