

Patients with Parkinson's disease and advance care planning

PURPOSE OF THIS STUDY:

This study explores patients', their caregivers', and healthcare providers' perspectives on the best approaches to engage in advance care planning (ACP) for end-of-life (EOL) care.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- English-speaking adults who have been diagnosed with advance stage Parkinson's disease.
- English-speaking adult caregivers of patient participants.
- English-speaking healthcare provider (HCP) who have direct experiences supporting patients with PD through advance care planning for end-of-life.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

- One 45-60-minute interview (in person or by telephone/skype) and one (possible) follow-up 30-60 minute interview.
- All participants will receive a \$10 gift card for their time
