

Online study: Diversity of sexual preferences

PURPOSE OF THIS STUDY:

We would like to explore different aspects of sexual identity among men and women who self-identify as asexual, bisexual, heterosexual, or homosexual.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

We are inviting men and women between the ages of 19-45, who self-identify as asexual, bisexual, heterosexual, or homosexual, and are able to read, write, and speak English.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

Participation in this study involves completion of an online questionnaire package assessing aspects related to your personal life (e.g., age, relationship status, employment), physical health (e.g., medication, medical conditions), sexual interest, birth order, and a measure of dominant handedness.

The questionnaire package will also include an assessment of digit length using an accepted 2D:4D finger ratio measure. Provided with detailed instructions, you will be asked to upload two photos: a photo of your right hand and a photo of your left hand. Total time involvement for participation is 45 minutes. An honorarium is provided to compensate you for your time.
