

# Hip and knee education-clinicians' interview

## PURPOSE OF THIS STUDY:

In order to improve delivery of education designed to prepare participants for hip or knee replacement surgery, the purpose of this study is to assess clinicians' experiences and perceptions of prehabilitation education and determine necessary measures for improving educational programming based on the perspective of clinicians who are working with osteoarthritis hip or knee patients.

## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Clinicians who are currently working with osteoarthritis hip or knee patients before or after their total hip/knee replacement surgery. Clinicians should also work in British Columbia.

## WHAT IS INVOLVED?

Clinicians will be asked to participate in a 45-60 minutes semi-structured interview. They can participate in an in-person interview or via phone/Skype.
