

Exploring patients' educational needs before their knee replacement surgery

PURPOSE OF THIS STUDY:

The purpose of this study is to assess patients' experiences and perceptions of pre-operative education and determine necessary measures for improving educational programming based on the perspective of patients who are undergoing total knee replacement surgery.

Patients who had or will have total knee replacement due to osteoarthritis.

Patients will be asked to participate in a 60-90 minutes focus group or a 45-60 minutes semi-structured interview.
